12	By order filed July 23, 2010, the court approved the parties' stipulation to extend	
13	plaintiff's time for filing a summary judgment motion from July 21, 2010, to September 24, 2010.	
14	Plaintiff was advised that the court did not anticipate approving more than one additional extension of	
15	time for the filing of plaintiff's motion and that any further extension for this purpose may not exceed	
16	thirty days. Plaintiff has submitted a stipulation and proposed order that does not set forth the total	
17	period of extensions already obtained, as required by Local Rule 144(b), and seeks approval of a second	
18	extension of time that exceeds thirty days. Plaintiff has not made a showing of good cause to grant a	
19	second extension of time that exceeds thirty days.
