

16 On April 30, 2010, the Magistrate Judge issued an order dismissing two of
17 defendants, Ogbeide and Vicks, from the complaint with leave to amend. On May 25, 2010,
18 plaintiff filed a motion for reconsideration of that order. Local Rule 303(b), states “rulings by
19 Magistrate Judges shall be final if no reconsideration thereof is sought from the Court within
20 fourteen (14) days . . . from the date of service of the ruling on the parties. . . .” Plaintiff’s
21 motion for reconsideration of the magistrate judge’s order of April 30, 2010 is therefore
22 untimely.

23 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff’s May 25, 2010, motion
24 for reconsideration (Docket No. 8) is denied.
