Dckt. No. 111. He further declared that he "would also request that Mr. Jamison's request for injunctive relief be granted, if a stipulation cannot be reached." *Id*.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Within fourteen days of the date of this order, the parties shall submit a stipulation and proposed order to the court resolving the issues raised in plaintiff's pro se motion for injunctive relief; or, plaintiff's counsel shall, after conferring with his client and complying with all ethical rules, withdraw the motion for injunctive relief; or, plaintiff's counsel shall write and file a properly noticed motion for injunctive relief in accordance with the local rules.
 - 2. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
- 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order upon plaintiff at his Yolo County Jail address.
