ORDER

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16 Plaintiffs are proceeding in this action pro se. Plaintiffs have requested authority  
17 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 to proceed in forma pauperis. This proceeding was referred to this  
18 court by Local Rule 72-302(c)(21).

19 Plaintiffs have submitted the affidavit required by § 1915(a) showing that they are  
20 unable to prepay fees and costs or give security for them. Accordingly, the request to proceed in  
21 forma pauperis will be granted. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a).

22 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 23 1. Plaintiffs' request to proceed in forma pauperis is granted;  
24 2. Plaintiffs shall obtain one USM-285 form for each defendant named in the  
25 complaint, one summons for each defendant and an instruction sheet. Blank USM-285 forms ,  
26 blank summons, and instruction sheets are available in the office of the Clerk of the Court;

1                   3. Within thirty days from the date of this order, plaintiffs shall complete the  
2 attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to the court with  
3 the following documents:

- 4                   a. One completed summons for each defendant named in the complaint;  
5                   b. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant named in the  
6                   complaint; and  
7                   c. Three copies of the endorsed complaint filed;

8                   4. Plaintiffs need not attempt service on defendants and need not request waiver  
9 of service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the court will direct the United  
10 States Marshal to serve the defendants pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 without  
11 prepayment of costs;

12                  5. Failure to comply with this order may result in a recommendation that this  
13 action be dismissed.
