17 Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant to 42  
18 U.S.C. § 1983. Pending before the court are plaintiff's requests for leave to proceed in forma  
19 pauperis (Docs. 2, 7, 8 and 9). Plaintiff's complaint will be addressed separately.

20 Plaintiff has submitted a declaration that makes the showing required by 28  
21 U.S.C. § 1915(a). The request to proceed in forma pauperis will, therefore, be granted.

22 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

23 1. Plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis is granted and the  
24 Clerk of Court is directed to terminate all pending in forma pauperis motions (Docs. 2, 7, 8 and  
25 9);

26 2. Plaintiff is required to pay the full statutory filing fee of \$350.00 for this

1 action pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914(a) and 1915(b)(1);

2 3. No initial partial filing fee will be assessed pursuant to 28 U.S.C.  
3 § 1915(b)(1); and

4 4. Plaintiff will be obligated for monthly payments of twenty percent of the  
5 preceding month's income credited to plaintiff's inmate trust account, such payments to be  
6 forwarded by the appropriate agency to the Clerk of the Court each time the amount in plaintiff's  
7 account exceeds \$10.00, until the statutory filing fee is paid in full, pursuant to 28 U.S.C.  
8 § 1915(b)(2).
