The matter was referred to a United States 18 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 19 On April 6, 2010, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 20 which were served on petitioner and which contained notice to petitioner that any objections to 21 the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Even though the 22 magistrate judge recommended that petitioners motion to stay be granted, petitioner filed 23 objections to the findings and recommendations. At this point, the court is at a loss to figure out 24 just what it is that petitioner wants the court to do, but this may be explained by the fact that he 25 is suffering from a mental illness. 26 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule

304, this court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1.
