22 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, pursuant to L.R. 144, by and between the parties
 23 Plaintiffs Friends of Amador County, Bea Crabtree, June Geary (Plaintiffs), Defendants Kenneth
 24 Salazar, Secretary of the Interior, the United States Department of the Interior, the National
 25 Indian Gaming Commission, and Tracie Stevens, Chairman of the National Indian Gaming
 26 Commission, (Federal Defendants), through their respective counsel, as follows:

27 The Court of Appeals, District of Columbia Circuit has recently decided the case of
 28 Amador County v. Salazar, 640 F.3d 373 (D.C. Cir. 2011). Given that decision's possible
 implications for the determination of this case, the parties have agreed to the need for additional
 time to formulate appropriate motions and briefs in support in this case.

1 Owing to this development and other contingencies, the parties have further agreed that
2 the schedule set forth by the Status (Pretrial Scheduling) Order of October 18, 2010 (Dkt. No.
3 26), be amended to allow filing of motions on or before August 17, 2011. Thereafter, all
4 motions, except motions for continuances, temporary restraining orders, or other emergency
5 applications, shall have been filed.

6 THEREFORE, parties' motions shall be filed on or before August 17, 2011.
