 21 that good cause exists to enter an order approving said Stipulation.

22 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 23 1. The hearing on Defendant Standard Insurance Company’s Motion for
 24 Summary Adjudication with Respect to Plaintiff’s Second Claim for Relief and
 25 Claim for Punitive Damages is continued to July 13, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.;

1 2. The deadline for hearing all dispositive motions, except motions for
2 continuances, temporary restraining orders, or other emergency applications, is
3 continued to July 13, 2011;

4 3. The deadline for the initial designation of expert witnesses and reports
5 is continued to July 29, 2011;

6 4. The deadline for the supplemental designation of expert witnesses and
7 reports is continued to August 12, 2011;

8 5. The deadline for the completion of expert discovery is continued to
9 August 26, 2011;


10 6. The Final Pretrial Conference is continued to September 14, 2011 at
11 11:00 a.m.;

12 7. The jury trial is continued to October 31, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.; and

13 8. The deadline for the completion of non-expert discovery remains on
14 June 10, 2011.

15 The court notes that this is the fourth stipulation to reset dates submitted by
16 parties. Future modifications to the scheduling order will not be made absent
17 extraordinary circumstances.
