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18	Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant to 42
19	U.S.C. § 1983. On March 19, 2010, and again on April 22, 2010, the court directed plaintiff to
20	resolve the fee status for this case within 30 days of the date of the order. Plaintiff was warned
21	that failure to comply may result in dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution and failure to
22	comply with court orders and rules. See Local Rule 110. To date, plaintiff has not complied by
23	either paying the full filing fee or filing a complete application for leave to proceed in forma
24	pauperis. In particular, while plaintiff has submitted various applications for leave to proceed in
25	forma pauperis (see Docs. 6, 7, and 9), none have been accompanied by the required certified
26	copy of plaintiff's prison trust account statement despite having been explicitly instructed on
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numerous occasions that such a statement is required to complete his application. Plaintiff shall show cause in writing, within 30 days of the date of this order, why this action should not be dismissed for failure to resolve fees. Plaintiff is again warned that failure to respond to this order may result in dismissal of the action for the reasons outlined above, as well as for failure to prosecute and comply with court rules and orders.
