
1 of the Western Area Power Administration... in connection with the

3 Related Cases 2:3-5.)

4 Under the regular practice of this court, related cases  
5 are generally assigned to the judge to whom the first filed action  
6 was assigned. Since the actions appear related, action  
7 No.2:10-cv-00791-LKK-KJN is reassigned to Judge Garland E. Burrell,  
8 Jr. and to Magistrate Gregory G. Hollows for all further  
9 proceedings, and any dates currently set in the reassigned case are  
10 vacated. Henceforth the caption on documents filed in the  
11 reassigned case shall show the initials "GEB-GGH."

12 Further, a status conference is scheduled in No.  
13 2:10-cv-00791-GEB-GGH before Judge Garland E. Burrell, Jr. on July  
14 26, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. A joint status report shall be filed no  
15 later than fourteen (14) days prior.<sup>1</sup>

16 The Clerk shall make appropriate adjustment in the  
17 assignment of civil cases to compensate for this reassignment.
