This case is before the undersigned pursuant to 18 both parties' consent. Docs. 3, 9. This case was reassigned to the undersigned on July 2, 2012. 19 Petitioner filed this petition seeking placement in a Residential Re-entry Center, as it seems his request to be transferred was denied by prison officials. Yet, it appears that 20 21 petitioner was released from custody on March 23, 2012, therefore the court cannot provide the 22 relief petitioner seeks. On July 3, 2012, the court ordered petitioner to show cause within 14 23 days why this case should not be dismissed as moot. That time has passed and petitioner has not 24 responded. The court notes that mail sent to petitioner has been returned to the court as 25 ///// \\\\\ 26 1

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1	undeliverable, yet it is petitioner's responsibility to keep the court apprised of his address.
2	Therefore this case is dismissed as moot and for failure to follow court orders.
3	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the case is dismissed and closed.
