1 In the interest of justice, the court will grant plaintiff's request, vacate its findings 2 and recommendations, and order plaintiff to complete new service documents for defendant 3 Naku. Plaintiff is cautioned, however, that if the United States Marshal is unable to effect 4 service again, the court will issue findings and recommendations recommending that defendant 5 Naku be dismissed. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 6 7 1. Plaintiff's March 1, 2011 request to attempt re-service (Doc. No. 29) is granted; 8 9 2. The court's March 3, 2011 findings and recommendations are vacated; 10 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff one summons, one USM-11 285 form, an instruction sheet, and a copy of the amended complaint filed June 16, 2010; and 12 4. Within thirty days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall complete the 13 attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit it to the court with the documents listed below: 14 15 a. One completed USM-285 form for defendant Naku; 16 b. Two copies of the endorsed complaint filed June 16, 2010; and 17 c. One completed summons form.
