16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant	
17	to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On May 25, 2010, plaintiff was informed that the certificate portion of the	
18	in forma pauperis application has not been filled out and signed by an authorized prison official	
19	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. On July 14, 2010, plaintiff filed a trust found account statement	
20	but has again failed to file the certificate portion of the in forma pauperis application that has	
21	been filled out and signed by an authorized prison official. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2). Plaintiff	
22	will be provided another opportunity to submit the completed application and the certified copy	
23	in support of his application to proceed in forma pauperis.	
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In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, the certificate portion of the in forma pauperis application. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed without prejudice.
- 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner.
