26 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, by and between the parties, through their respective  
 27 counsel of record, that this action be remanded to the Commissioner of Social Security for further  
 28 administrative action pursuant to section 205(g) of the Social Security Act, as amended, 42  
 U.S.C. § 405(g), sentence four.

1 On remand, the Appeals Council will instruct the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to take  
2 the following action:

3 To further consider the opinions of all treating sources, including the opinion of Dr. Lui,  
4 in assessing Plaintiff's residual functional capacity, and to provide rationale for the weight  
5 accorded to each opinion. If warranted, the ALJ should obtain supplemental vocational expert  
6 testimony to assist in determining Plaintiff's ability to perform jobs existing in significant  
7 numbers in the national economy.

8 The parties further request that the Clerk of the Court be directed to enter a final judgment  
9 in favor of Plaintiff, and against Defendant, Commissioner of Social Security, reversing the final  
10 decision of the Commissioner.
