1	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between Plaintiffs Michael P. Lessard and Robert L.

4	WHEREAS, on March 29, 2010, Plaintiffs commenced this action against Defendant
5	Trinity Protection Services, Inc. in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of San
6	Joaquin;
7	WHEREAS, on May 21, 2010, Defendant timely removed the action to this district;
8	WHEREAS, trial of this matter is currently set for April 9, 2012;
9	WHEREAS, the non-expert discovery deadline is currently set for June 9, 2011;
10	WHEREAS, on March 29, 2011 the Parties participated in a settlement conference presided
11	over by Judge Kendall J. Newman;
