 26 circulation or on the official internet government forfeiture

1 2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides
2 that the Court shall designate by order the appropriate newspaper
3 or other vehicle for publication;

4 3. The defendant Approximately \$75,750.00 in U.S. Currency
5 (hereafter "defendant \$75,750.00"), Approximately \$27,910.00 in
6 U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant \$27,910.00"), and 2006
7 Bristers TW413 Trail Wagon, VIN: BDMUTXH1K7A09112A (hereafter
8 "defendant utility vehicle"), were seized at 28953 Highway 49,

4 (6) A statement that answers to the Complaint or
5 a motion under Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure
6 ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 21 days after
7 the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may
8 be entered and condemnation ordered.


