Plaintiff in this case has filed a request for leave to file a late opposition to Defendant JP Morgan's motion to dismiss. In his request, plaintiff explained that he intended to file an opposition to JP Morgan's motion to dismiss concurrently with his opposition to Paramount Residential Mortgage's motion to dismiss.
