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17	Plaintiff, an incarcerated individual proceeding without counsel, has filed a civil
18	rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 together with a request for leave to proceed in forma
19	pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. Plaintiff has not, however, filed his application for leave
20	to proceed in forma pauperis on the form used by this district. Use of the form assists plaintiff to
21	establish and the court to evaluate plaintiff's in forma pauperis status in light of 28 U.S.C. § 1915
22	(b)(1) and (2). Accordingly, plaintiff's current in forma pauperis application will be dismissed
23	and plaintiff will be provided the opportunity to submit the application on the appropriate form.
24	Plaintiff is cautioned that he must also provide a certified copy of his prison trust account
25	statement for the six month period immediately preceding the filing of his complaint.
26	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
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1	1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis is dismissed without
2	prejudice (Dkt. No. 4);
3	2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to
4	Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner; and
5	3. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a
6	completed application to proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order
7	may result in the dismissal of this action without prejudice.
