Petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis is denied; 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send petitioner a copy of the in forma 6 7 pauperis form used by this district; 4. Respondents are directed to file a response to petitioner's habeas petition 8 9 within sixty days from the date of this order. See Rule 4, Fed. R. Governing § 2254 Cases. An 10 answer shall be accompanied by all transcripts and other documents relevant to the issues 11 presented in the petition. See Rule 5, Fed. R. Governing § 2254 Cases; 5. If the response to the habeas petition is an answer, petitioner's reply, if any, 12 shall be filed and served within twenty-eight days after service of the answer; 13 6.
