Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel and in forma pauperis in an action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. In his objections to the January 31, 2011 findings and recommendations for dismissal, plaintiff requests an extension of time to file an amended complaint in accordance with the court’s December 10, 2010 order. *See* Fed.
