| 16 | U.S.C. § 2254. On September 9, 2011, petitioner requested an extension of time to file and serve |
| 17 | objections to the August 31, 2011 findings and recommendations granting respondent's motion |
| 18 | to dismiss. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(b). The purpose of the objection period is not to brief the |
| 19 | merits of respondent's motion in the first instance. Petitioner has already had the opportunity to |
| 20 | oppose respondent's motion and has had ample time to research the relevant legal issues. |
| 21 | Accordingly, it is ORDERED that petitioner's September 9, 2011 request is granted to |
| 22 | the extent that plaintiff has until September 27, 2011 to file objections to the August 31, 2011 |
| 23 | findings and recommendations. Absent a showing of substantial cause, the court does not intend |
| 24 | to grant further extensions of time. |
