Because plaintiff is represented by counsel, he may communicate with the court only through his counsel. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. Within fourteen days of the date of this order, plaintiff's counsel shall inform the court whether plaintiff's September 29, 2014 "motion for levy of settlement agreement" may be disregarded or whether counsel intends to file additional briefing in support of plaintiff's motion; 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on plaintiff Anthony Turner, CDCR # G27511, Salinas Valley State Prison, P.O. Box 1050, Soledad, California, 93960. Dated: October 16, 2014 Tur1848.ord UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE would make a good-faith effort to pay the settlement within 180 days of plaintiff delivering to defendant the settlement documents. Defendant states that barely a month has passed since those documents were returned to defendant and CDCR is still processing plaintiff's settlement

payment. Defendants also correctly observe that plaintiff is free to pursue a separate legal action

regarding his claims that prison officials at SVSP are violating his constitutional rights as these

claims are unrelated to the instant action.
