16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action
17	seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate
18	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
19	On December 8, 2011, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations
20	herein which were served on plaintiff and defendant Gandy and which contained notice to them
21	that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within twenty-one days.
22	Neither party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations.
23	The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be
24	supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY
25	ORDERED that:
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1	1. The findings and recommandations filed December 9, 2011, are adopted in
1 2	1. The findings and recommendations filed December 8, 2011, are adopted in full;
3	2. Defendant Gandy's motion to dismiss (Doc. No. 20) is granted in part and
4	denied in part as follows:
5	a. Defendant's motion to dismiss pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6) is denied;
6	b. Defendant's motion to dismiss pursuant to unenumerated Rule 12(b) is
7	granted; and
8	3. Plaintiff's motion to supplement his complaint (Doc. No. 37) is denied as
9	moot.
