Plaintiff in this case brings claims arising out of his mortgage. Defendant Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. has filed a motion to dismiss noticed for hearing on October 12, 2010. 2. Hearing on defendant's motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 6) is CONTINUED to October 25, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.

3. Plaintiff shall file and serve his opposition or statement of non-opposition on or before October 11, 2010. Defendant may file and serve a reply no later than October 18, 2010.
