1 Based on plaintiff's Request for Dismissal, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED 2 that: 3 1. Plaintiff's complaint be dismissed with prejudice, with each party to bear his or her own fees and costs. 4 5 2. The Clerk of Court be directed to close this case and vacate all dates in this case. 6 7 It is FURTHER ORDERED that all dates before the undersigned are vacated. 8 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District 9 Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen 10 days after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written 11 objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Id.; see also E. Dist. Local Rule 304(b). Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and 12 13 Recommendations." Any response to the objections shall be filed with the court and served on all parties within fourteen days after service of the objections. E. Dist. Local Rule 304(d). 14 15 Failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District 16 Court's order. Turner v.
