16	Petitioner is a state prisoner without counsel seeking a writ of habeas corpus. See 28
17	U.S.C. § 2254. On September 30, 2010, the undersigned recommended that this action be
18	dismissed because petitioner has not paid the filing fee or filed a completed in forma pauperis
19	application. Dckt. No. 8. On October 27, 2010, petitioner filed a letter with the court, stating
20	that he was transferred to a new prison, has been without his personal property, and has not had
21	access to a pen or paper. Dckt. No. 11. Petitioner therefore requests "more time." Id. The court
22	construes petitioner's letter as a request for an extension of time to either pay the filing fee or file
23	a completed in forma pauperis application. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(b).
24	Good cause appearing, it is ORDERED that petitioner's October 27, 2010 letter,
25	construed as a request for an extension of time, is granted and petitioner has 30 days from the
26	date this order is served to either pay the filing fee or file a completed in forma pauperis
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application. Should petitioner fail to comply with this order, the September 30, 2010 findings
and recommendations will be submitted to the District Judge. The Clerk of the Court is directed
to mail to petitioner a form application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
