On March 24, 2011, the court ordered: 1) defendants in the above-captioned action to file answers to plaintiff’s amended complaint within twenty-one (21) days of being served the amended complaint; and 2) all parties to inform the court of the optimal timing and method for settlement discussions within twenty-one (21) days of the issuance of the order. (ECF 30.) Defendant Yeanina Oliva has failed to comply with the March 24, 2011 court order.
