10	WHEREAS, Plaintiff Maranvilles' complaint before the Federal Equal Employment
11	Opportunity Commission has been forwarded to the Department of Justice for action;

13	WHEREAS, Plaintiffs' counsel have met and conferred with Defendants' counsel
14	William J. Gorham III, and have agreed a STAY and a CONTINUANCE is in the best
15	interest of the parties and judicial economy;

17	THEREFORE IT IS SO ORDERED, Plaintiffs request for (1.) a STAY of this action for
18	an additional NINETY DAYS until July 15, 2011, for the Defendants to file a responsive
19	pleading and (2.) an additional CONTINUANCE of the STATUS (PRETRIAL
20	SCHEDULING) CONFERENCE until August 22, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. The parties shall
21	file status reports fourteen (14) days prior to the status conference.
