ORDER


On October 12, 2011, plaintiff filed a document entitled “Objections to Magistrate Judge’s Order In Re Plaintiff’s Allegation of Judicial Bias,” and noticed a hearing before the undersigned on October 20, 2011 (Dkt. No. 31).¹ Although unclear in most respects, plaintiff’s “objections” do not actually seek any concrete relief relative to the undersigned’s order entered September 29, 2011, which addressed plaintiff’s allegation of judicial bias (Dkt. No. 26). Instead, plaintiff’s objections more directly address proposed findings and recommendations that the undersigned filed on July 13, 2011 (Dkt. No. 22), which were fully adopted by the district judge assigned to this case on September 6, 2011 (Dkt. No. 25).
