1 2. Local Rule 171, Eastern District of California, provides
2 that the Court shall designate by order the appropriate newspaper
3 or other vehicle for publication;

4 3. The defendants Approximately \$28,580.00 in U.S.
5 Currency, Approximately \$16,039.00 in U.S. Currency, and
6 Approximately \$30,000.00 in U.S. Currency seized from Bank of
7 America safe deposit box 1481C, (collectively, "defendant
8 currency"), were seized in the city of Sacramento in Sacramento
