On March 8, 2011, the court ordered petitioner to file an in forma pauperis affidavit or pay the required filing fee within thirty days. On April 4, 2011, the court granted petitioner an extension of time to comply with the order. Petitioner has not filed an in forma pauperis affidavit or paid the required filing fee.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice.

Within twenty-one days after being served with these findings and recommendations, petitioner may file written objections with the court. The document should be captioned “Objections to Magistrate Judge’s Findings and Recommendations.” Petitioner is advised that failure to file objections within the

1 specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951
2 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
