In order to properly commence a civil rights action, plaintiff must file a complaint.

See Fed. R. Civ. P. 3. Accordingly, the Clerk of the Court will be directed to send plaintiff a form civil rights complaint and accompanying instructions and plaintiff will be granted a period of thirty days in which to complete and file the complaint.

The court views the allegations of plaintiff's motion for temporary restraining order as sufficiently serious that the will request the California Attorney General to file, within thirty days, an informal response to the motion. The court will also send a copy of plaintiff's motion to the Receiver in Plata v. Schwarzenegger, No. C-01-1351 TEH (N.D. Cal.)

In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis is dismissed without prejudice;
- 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner and a form civil rights complaint and accompanying instructions;
- 3. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis and a completed complaint;
- 4. The court intends to consider plaintiff's request for temporary restraining order and will consider any response submitted by the Office of the California Attorney General within thirty days from the date of this order.
- 5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order and a copy of plaintiff's motion for temporary restraining order and accompanying affidavit on Supervising
