This matter comes before the Court on Defendant Union Pacific Railroad Company's ("Defendant") Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 16) Plaintiff Leah Cook's ("Plaintiff") First Amended Complaint ("FAC") (Doc. 15), pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6). 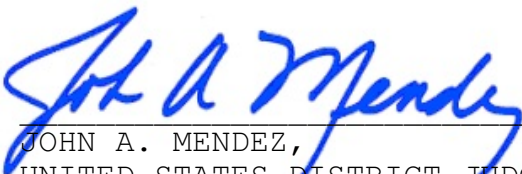
1 requires a party responding to a motion to file either an
2 opposition to the motion or a statement of non-opposition, no
3 less than fourteen (14) days preceding the noticed hearing date.
4 Local Rule 110 authorizes the Court to impose sanctions for
5 "failure of counsel or of a party to comply with these Rules."
6 Therefore, the Court will sanction Plaintiff's counsel,
7 Choudhary Law Office, \$150.00 unless it shows good cause for its
8 failure to comply with the Local Rules.

10 ORDER

11 After carefully considering the papers submitted in this
12 matter, it is hereby ordered that Defendant's Motion to Dismiss
13 is GRANTED, WITH PREJUDICE. It is further ordered that within
14 ten (10) days of this Order Nilesh Choudhary shall either (1)
15 pay sanctions of \$150.00 to the Clerk of the Court, or (2)
16 submit a statement of good cause explaining his failure to
17 comply with Local Rule 230(c).
