 JOINT STIPULATION AND PROPOSED
 ORDER RE: EXTENSION OF TIME TO
 RESPOND TO COMPLAINT

16 This is an immigration case in which plaintiff challenges the determination of inadmissibility
 17 pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1882(a)(6)(C)(I), the denial of her Application By Refugee For Waiver of
 18 Grounds of Excludability, and her application for adjustment of status by U.S. Citizenship and
 19 Immigration Services' (CIS). The parties previously stipulated to one 30-day extension of time
 20 for the government to prepare its answer or other responsive pleading. The parties now advise
 21 that the matter will be reopened at the administrative level, and a Request for Evidence issued in
 22 advance of a reconsideration of the applications. It is expected that this process will be
 23 completed within three months. Accordingly, the parties stipulate to a second, 120-day
 24 extension, until June 10, 2011, for the filing of the joint status report and the government's
 answer or responsive pleading.
