19 This is an immigration case in which plaintiff has challenged the delay in the adjudication of  
20 his application to adjust status to that of lawful permanent resident by U.S. Citizenship and  
21 Immigration Services (CIS). The parties stipulate to a 30-day extension of time in which to file  
22 both the government's answer to the complaint and the joint status report, as the parties explore  
23 the possibility of a resolution at the administrative level.

24 The parties therefore stipulate that the time for filing the government's answer be extended to  
25 May 2, 2011, and that the scheduling conference, currently set for April 25, 2011, be reset to  
26 sometime after the new answer due date.
