Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals that these actions are related within the meaning of Local Rule 123(a) because the plaintiffs are the same in both cases, most of the defendants are the same in both cases, and both cases involve similar claims. Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same judge is likely to effect a substantial saving of judicial effort and is also likely to be convenient for the parties.

The parties should be aware that relating the cases under Local Rule 123 merely has the result that both actions are assigned to the same judge; no consolidation of the actions is effected. Under the regular practice of this court, related cases are generally assigned to the judge and magistrate to whom the first filed action was assigned.

Wadhwa, et al. v. Aurora Loan Services, LLC et al., Civ. No. 2:10-03361 WBS DAD and Wadhwa, et al., v. Aurora Loan Services, LLC, et al., Civ. No. 2:11-01525 FCD GGH, be, and the same hereby are, deemed related and the case denominated Wadhwa, et al., v. Aurora Loan Services, LLC, et al., Civ. No. 2:11-01525 FCD GGH, shall be reassigned to the Honorable WILLIAM B. SHUBB and Magistrate Judge Dale A. Drozd for all further proceedings. Any dates currently set in the reassigned case only are hereby VACATED. Henceforth, the caption on documents filed in the reassigned case shall be shown as Wadhwa, et al., v. Aurora Loan Services, LLC, et al., Civ. No. 2:11-01525 WBS DAD.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court

make appropriated adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to compensate for this reassignment.
