18	Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding without counsel, has filed a petition for a
19	writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, together with an application to proceed in
20	forma pauperis. Petitioner is incarcerated in Arizona and challenges his 2003 conviction in
21	California's San Joaquin County Superior Court.
22	Examination of the in forma pauperis application reveals that petitioner is unable
23	to afford the costs of suit. Accordingly, the application to proceed in forma pauperis will be
24	granted. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a).
25	Because petitioner may be entitled to relief if the claimed violation of
26	constitutional rights is proved, respondents will be directed to file a response to petitioner's

2	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
3	1. Petitioner's application to proceed in forma pauperis is granted;
4	2. Respondents are directed to file a response to petitioner's habeas petition
5	within sixty days from the date of this order. See Rule 4, Fed. R. Governing § 2254 Cases. An
6	answer shall be accompanied by all transcripts and other documents relevant to the issues
7	presented in the petition. See Rule 5, Fed. R. Governing § 2254 Cases;
8	3. If the response to the habeas petition is an answer, petitioner's reply, if any,
9	shall be filed and served within twenty-eight days after service of the answer;
10	4. If the response to the habeas petition is a motion, petitioner's opposition or
11	statement of non-opposition to the motion shall be filed and served within twenty-eight days after
12	service of the motion, and respondents' reply, if any, shall be filed and served within fourteen
13	days thereafter; and
14	5. The Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this order, the consent/
15	reassignment form contemplated by Appendix A(k) to the Local Rules of this court, and a copy
16	of the petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 on Michael Patrick Farrell,
17	Senior Assistant Attorney General.
