
In accordance with the provisions of Rule 16 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. A Status (Pretrial Scheduling) Conference is set for **March 11, 2011 at 11:00 a.m.** before the undersigned in Courtroom No. 27.
2. The parties shall file a joint status report on or before March 4, 2011.
3. The parties' joint status report shall address the following matters:
  - a. Possible joinder of additional parties;

- 1 b. Any expected or desired amendment of the  
2 pleadings;  
3 c. Jurisdiction and venue;  
4 d. Anticipated motions and the scheduling thereof;  
5 e. Anticipated discovery and the scheduling thereof,  
6 including disclosure of expert witnesses;  
7 f. Future proceedings, including the setting of  
8 appropriate cut-off dates for discovery and for law  
9 and motion, the scheduling of final pretrial  
10 conference and trial, and an estimate of the length of  
11 the trial;  
12 g. Modification of standard pretrial procedures  
13 specified by the rules due to the relative simplicity  
14 or complexity of the action;  
15 h. Whether the case is related to any other case,  
16 including matters in bankruptcy;  
17 i. Whether the parties will stipulate to the assigned  
18 magistrate judge acting as settlement judge, waiving  
19 any disqualification by virtue of his so acting, or  
20 whether they prefer to have a Settlement Conference  
21 before another magistrate judge; and  
22 j. Any other matters that may aid in the just and  
23 expeditious disposition of this action.

24 4. Any party may appear at the status conference telephonically. To arrange  
25 telephonic appearance, counsel shall contact Pete Buzo, courtroom deputy to the undersigned, at  
26 (916) 930-4128, at least 48 hours prior to the status conference.
