**ORDER & WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
AD TESTIFICANDUM**

Thomas John Heilman, CDCR # H-76785, a necessary and material witness in a settlement conference in this case on October 29, 2019, is confined in the Correctional Training Facility (CTF), in the custody of the Warden. In order to secure this inmate's attendance it is necessary that a Writ of Habeas Corpus ad Testificandum issue commanding the custodian to produce the inmate before Magistrate Judge Kendall J. Newman, by video conference from his place of confinement, to the U. S. District Court, Courtroom #25, 501 I Street, Sacramento, California 95814, on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at 9:00 a.m.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A Writ of Habeas Corpus ad Testificandum issue, under the seal of this court, commanding the Warden to produce the inmate named above, by video conference, to participate in a settlement conference at the time and place above, until completion of the settlement conference or as ordered by the court.
2. The custodian is ordered to notify the court of any change in custody of this inmate and is ordered to provide the new custodian with a copy of this writ.
3. Counsel for the defendant, the assigned Deputy Attorney General, shall confirm with the prison no less than two days prior to the settlement conference that the prison's video-conference equipment will connect to the court's system. Any difficulties shall immediately be reported to Alexandra Waldrop, Courtroom Deputy, at (916) 930-4187.
