**STIPULATED ORDER TO ALLOW  
MENTAL EXAMINATION OF  
PLAINTIFF JERALD CLINTON (J.C.)  
EAGLESMITH**

PLAINTIFF JERALD CLINTON (J.C.) EAGLESMITH AND DEFENDANTS  
PLUMAS COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION/PLUMAS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT,  
SUE SEGURA AND JEFF RAY BY AND THROUGH THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD,  
HEREBY STIPULATE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Plaintiff Jerald Clinton (J.C.) Eaglesmith (“Plaintiff”) will undergo an independent mental examination (“IME”);

1           2.       The mental examination of Plaintiff referenced herein is proper because Plaintiff  
2 has put his mental and psychological condition at issue in this action;

3           3.       That the examination will occur on April 18, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. at Esquire  
4 Deposition Services, located at 2151 River Plaza Dr., Ste. 300, Sacramento, California, 95833,  
5 telephone number (916) 446-2700, and will be conducted by Jeffrey Gould, M.D.

6           4.       That said examination will consist of an oral interview and evaluation of Plaintiff,  
7 the procurement of Plaintiff's life and psychological history, and psychological testing of  
8 Plaintiff, and will not exceed 8 hours. The parties anticipate that the examination will consist of  
9 tests standard in psychological evaluations, including a clinical interview and brief cognitive  
10 screening. With respect to an assessment of emotional functions and the plaintiff's personality,  
11 his or her personality status and attitude toward illness, plaintiff will be examined through the  
12 administration of one or more of the following measures: the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality  
13 Inventory-2 (MMPI-2), the Millon Clinical Multiaxial Inventory-III (MCMI-III), and the  
14 Incomplete Sentences Blank.

15           5.       That said examination will not consist of any tests or procedures which would be  
16 painful, protracted or intrusive to Plaintiff.

17           6.       That an IME report will be prepared by Defendants' designated expert Jeffrey  
18 Gould, M.D., within thirty days after the date of the examination, or by May 18, 2012, and will be  
19 made available to plaintiffs' counsel at that time.
