20	of the Eighth Amendment's proscription against cruel and unusual punishment. By order filed	
21	September 30, 2015, the district judge denied defendant's motion for summary judgment and

23	123 (Order declining to adopt the undersigned's Findings and Recommendations filed March 3,	
24	2015, ECF No. 118).	
25	Before scheduling this case for trial, the court will inquire into the parties' interests in	
26	participating in a settlement conference mediated by another magistrate judge.
