

Oracle America, Inc. has “decline[d] to continue to press [its] motion” to dismiss Google Inc.’s invalidity counterclaims and strike certain affirmative defenses and impertinent matter, because required disclosures and discovery responses “will achieve the practical objective of giving [Oracle] fair notice of what Google has in mind in defending this case” (Reply 3).
