

**[PROPOSED] ORDER**

Plaintiff is a state prisoner, proceeding through counsel. On April 24, 2020, defendants Donahoo, Salas, Walker, Bradford, Lynch, Virga, Morrow and Gaddi moved for an order granting relief from the 20-page limitation contained in Judge Nunley’s standing information.
