JAS was served with the FAC on June 8, 2011. SBT has not been 20 allow to for further settlement 21 negotiations. Neither Defendant has filed any responsive pleading to the original Complaint or 22 the FAC. 23 2. Due to the present state of the case, this report was not filed jointly and a discovery 24 and motion plan has not been set. Plaintiff anticipates, however, that the case will follow due 25 course and does not anticipate any circumstances should it not settle. 26 The parties will be in a better situation 27 to evaluate any discovery and motion plan once all parties have been served and Defendants have filed 28 any necessary responsive pleadings.

(ECF No. 11, 1:21-2:2.) Plaintiff does not indicate what steps it is taking to prosecute this action in the event the referenced settlement negotiations do not resolve this action.

Therefore, no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 18, 2011 Plaintiff shall either file whatever documents are required to prosecute this case as a default matter, or a document showing cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure of prosecution

Further, the status conference scheduled for hearing on June 27, 2011, is continued to commence at 9:00 a.m. on August 29, 2011. A status report shall be filed fourteen (14) days prior to the status conference.
