**PLAINTIFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION
 OF TIME TO FILE DISPOSITIONAL
 DOCUMENTS RE: SETTLEMENT; ORDER**

21 On August 14, 2014, this Court issued a minute order that all dispositional documents regarding
 22 settlement of this case were to be filed by not later than October 14, 2014. Both counsel for Plaintiff
 23 and counsel for the United States of America request an extension of 30 days for the filing of the
 24 dispositional documents.

26 Shortly after agreeing to the settlement of this case, Plaintiff Peggy Boynton traveled to North
 27 Carolina to visit a sick relative. While there, Ms. Boynton herself suffered a serious injury and was

7 Counsel for the United States in this matter, Bobbie J. Montoya, has agreed to the requested extension.
