22	The court has received the Notice of Related Cases filed May 5, 2011.
23	Examination of the above-entitled actions reveals that the actions are related within the meaning
24	of Local Rule 123(a). The actions involve many of the same parties, and are based on the same
25	or similar claims, the same property, transaction or event, similar questions of fact and the same
26	question of law. Accordingly, the assignment of the matters to the same judge and magistrate

judge is likely to effect a substantial savings of judicial effort and is also likely to be convenient
 for the parties.

The parties should be aware that relating the cases under Local Rule 123 merely has the result that the actions are assigned to the same judge and magistrate judge; no consolidation of the actions is effected. Under the regular practice of this court, related cases are generally assigned to the judge and magistrate judge to whom the first filed action was assigned.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

a.m. in courtroom #26 before the undersigned. The parties shall submit to the court and serve by
mail on all other parties, no later than seven days before the scheduling conference, a status

discovery and law and motion and the scheduling of a pretrial conference and trial;
