The defendants Approximately \$156,000.00 in U.S. Currency and Approximately \$2,839.00 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant currency") were seized in the city of Chico, in Butte County, California. 10		(5)	A statement that claims of persons entitled to possession or	
11	claiming an interest pursuant to Supplemental Rule $G(5)$ must be filed with the Court and served			
12	on the attorney for the United States no later than 60 days after the first day of publication on the			
13	official internet government forfeiture site; and			
14		(6)	A statement that answers to the Complaint or a motion under Rule	
15	12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Fed. R. Civ. P.") must be filed and served within 21			
16	days after the filing of the claims and, in the absence thereof, default may be entered and			
17	condemnation ordered.
