ORDER

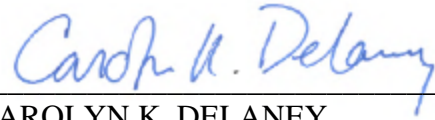
Plaintiff has requested a sixth extension of time to file his pretrial statement. Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
