2 2. The Parties stipulate to Judgment and division of the \$264,137.79 in life insurance
3 proceeds deposited with the Court as follows. The following allocation of life insurance
4 proceeds represents an equal division of proceeds to each of the four Parties, after taking into
5 account the \$25,000.00 already distributed to Defendant Aleraj before the above-referenced case
6 was filed:

- 7 a. An amount equal to \$72,284.45 shall be distributed to each of the Nasri
8 Children. The share allocated to any minor Nasri child shall be distributed
9 to Shelley Nasri, as court-appointed Guardian Ad Litem of such child and
10 held in trust for the benefit of such child;
- 11 b. An amount equal to \$47,284.44 shall be distributed to Defendant Aleraj;
- 12 c. Any interest which has accumulated on the principal amount deposited
13 shall be divided into four (4) equal portions, with one such portion to be
14 distributed to each of the Parties;
- 15 d. In the event that the total life insurance proceeds available for distribution
16 is less than \$264,137.79, the division and distribution of such proceeds
17 shall be made as follows:
 - 18 i. The total amount of proceeds available for distribution shall be
19 divided into four (4) equal shares;
 - 20 ii. One such share shall be reduced by an amount equal to \$18,750.00
21 (representing the \$25,000.00 previously distributed to Defendant
22 Aleraj, after crediting back her 1/4 share of such amount) and
23 distributed to Defendant Aleraj; and
 - 24 iii. The other three (3) shares shall each be increased by an amount
25 equal to \$6,250.00 (1/4 of the \$25,000.00 previously distributed to
26 Defendant Aleraj). One such share shall then be distributed to each
27 of the Nasri Children.

18 enter an Order approving the Stipulation,


19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the \$264,137.79 in life insurance proceeds deposited
20 with the Court be distributed by the Clerk as follows:

- 21 a. An amount equal to \$72,284.45 shall be distributed to each of the Nasri Children.
22 The share allocated to any minor Nasri child shall be distributed to Shelley Nasri,
23 as court-appointed Guardian Ad Litem of such child and held in trust for the
24 benefit of such child;
- 25 b. An amount equal to \$47,284.44 shall be distributed to Defendant Aleraj;
- 26 c. Any interest which has accumulated on the principal amount deposited shall be
27 divided into four (4) equal portions, with one such portion to be distributed to
28 each of the Parties;

- d. In the event that the total life insurance proceeds available for distribution is less than \$264,137.79, the division and distribution of such proceeds shall be made as follows:
 - i. The total amount of proceeds available for distribution shall be divided into four (4) equal shares;
 - ii. One such share shall be reduced by an amount equal to \$18,750.00 (representing the \$25,000.00 previously distributed to Defendant Aleraj, after crediting back her 1/4 share of such amount) and distributed to Defendant Aleraj; and
 - iii. The other three (3) shares shall each be increased by an amount equal to \$6,250.00 (1/4 of the \$25,000.00 previously distributed to Defendant Aleraj). One such share shall then be distributed to each of the Nasri Children.
