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Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff, the only party to appear in this action, has consented to proceed before a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). See Consent filed September 8, 2011. By an order filed August 23, 2011, this court ordered plaintiff to complete and return to the court, within thirty days, the USM-285 forms necessary to effect service on defendants. Review of the docket on November 7, 2011, suggested that plaintiff had not complied with the court's order. Accordingly, on that day plaintiff was ordered to show cause in writing why this action should not be dismissed.
